



**NOTICE OF INTENT
INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION
CITY OF CAMPBELL, CALIFORNIA**

Notice is hereby given of the intent of the Campbell City Council to adopt a Negative Declaration pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21092(b)(1) for the City initiated rescission of 14 structures from the Historic Resource Inventory. The 14 structures have been demolished, significantly altered, or significantly neglected to the point that the structures no longer meet the City's criteria for historic designation.

The 14 structures are or were located in the City of Campbell: 175 E. Campbell Avenue; 386 N. Central Avenue; 56 Foote Avenue; 500 W. Latimer Avenue; 1510 More Avenue; 16172 Mozart Avenue; 206 E. Rincon Avenue; 187 E. Sunnyoaks Avenue; 68 Sunnyside Avenue; 188 Sunnyside Avenue; 75 Union Avenue; 346 Union Avenue; 356 Union Avenue; and 518-534 Rodeck Way (address no longer exists).

The Initial Study prepared by the City was undertaken for the purpose of determining whether the project may have a significant effect on the environment. On the basis of the Initial Study, Community Development Department staff has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment, and therefore, has prepared a draft Negative Declaration for consideration by the Campbell City Council. The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requires this notice to disclose whether any listed toxic sites are present at the location. The project location does not contain a toxic site pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

All interested parties are invited and encouraged to submit comments in writing regarding the draft Negative Declaration and/or attend the below described public hearings. The public review period for the draft Negative Declaration ends on August 21, 2018. Any comments must be submitted in writing, including email, to the Community Development Department by 5:00 p.m. on August 21, 2018. The Initial Study and draft Negative Declaration are available for review from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Community Development Department, City Hall, 70 North First Street, Campbell, CA or online at <http://www.cityofcampbell.com/501/Public-Notices> under ' Environmental Notices'.

The Campbell City Council will consider the project and draft Negative Declaration at a public hearing to be held on **August 21, 2018**. The meeting will be held at 7:30 p.m., or shortly thereafter, in the City Hall City Council Chambers, 70 North First Street, Campbell, CA.

Please be advised that if you challenge the decision on the Negative Declaration and/or project in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearings described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Campbell prior to the public hearings.
