NOTICE OF TREE REMOVAL PERMIT APPLICATION

Notice is hereby given that the Community Development Department of the City of Campbell has received an application for a Tree Removal Permit (PLN-2020-5) for the removal of one (4) trees (one Deodar Cedar and three Monterey Pines) at **100 Union Avenue** located near the center and front of the property, If approved, removal of the trees is subject to the replanting requirement of the Campbell Municipal Code.

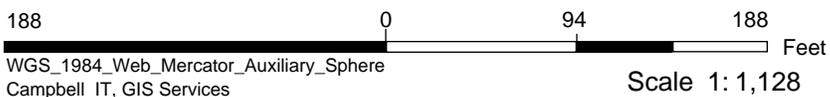
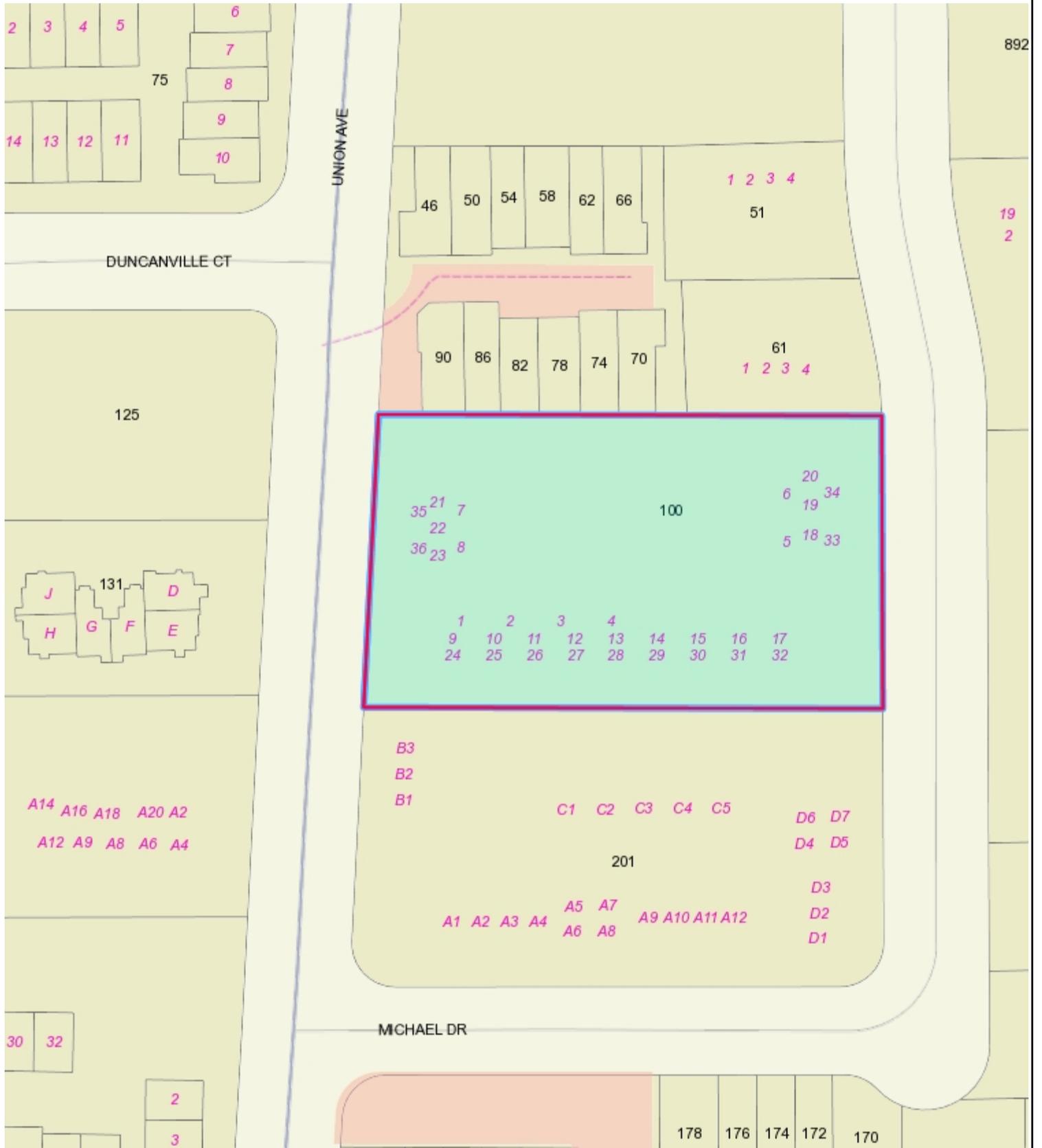
This is your opportunity to provide comments. The 10-day comment period for this application will begin on March 2, 2020, and end on March 11, 2020. Comments regarding this application must be submitted in writing (including email) to the Planning Division before 5:00 p.m. on **March 11, 2020**. No additional notice will be provided. A copy of the Tree Removal Permit application, and all associated documents, are available for review from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Community Development Department, City Hall, 70 North First Street, Campbell, California and on the City's 'Public Notices' web page (<http://www.cityofcampbell.com/501/Public-Notices>) under 'Administrative Decisions'.

Decisions by the Community Development Director are final in 10 calendar days following the date of approval, unless an appeal is received in writing (including email) at the Community Development Department, 70 N. First Street, Campbell, prior to the end of the appeal period. A written appeal must be accompanied with the required \$200 appeal filing fee.
