**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council for the City of Campbell has set the hour of 7:30 p.m. or soon thereafter on **Tuesday, March 2, 2021**, at 70 N. First Street, Campbell, California, as the time and place for a for a Public Hearing to consider approving a City-Initiated General Plan Amendment (PLN-2020-151) to the North of Campbell Avenue Area (NOCA) plan and related sections of the General Plan to incorporate Objective Standards and procedures in accordance with recent changes to state law. Staff is recommending that this item be deemed Categorical Exempt under CEQA.

While members of the public will not be able to attend the meeting of the Campbell City Council physically, the meeting will be live-streamed on YouTube at (<https://www.youtube.com/user/CityofCampbell>).

This public hearing will be conducted via telecommunication and is compliant with provisions of the Brown Act and Executive Order N-29-20 issued by the Governor.
