NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council for the City of Campbell has set the hour of 7:30 p.m. or soon thereafter on **Tuesday, April 6, 2021**, at 70 N. First Street, Campbell, California, as the time and place for a for a Public Hearing to consider the application of Akbar Abdollahi for a Planned Development Permit (PLN-2018-225) to allow the construction of nine (9) single family residences, a new private street, and associated site and landscaping improvements; a Tentative Subdivision Map to subdivide the site into nine (9) single-family lots with one (1) common lot; a Parking Modification Permit to allow a reduction in the number of required parking spaces; a Tree Removal Permit to allow the removal of one (1) fruitless mulberry tree; and a Variance to allow the retention of existing overhead utility lines and/or the placement of new poles for property located at **202 W. Rincon Avenue**. Staff is recommending that this item be deemed Categorically Exempt under CEQA.

While members of the public will not be able to attend the meeting of the Campbell City Council physically, the meeting will be live-streamed on YouTube at (<https://www.youtube.com/user/CityofCampbell>).

This public hearing will be conducted via telecommunication and is compliant with provisions of the Brown Act and Executive Order N-29-20 issued by the Governor.

In the event that the provisions of Executive Order N-29-20 are modified or suspended before the date of the meeting so as to require physical attendance by participants, the meeting will be held in the City Council Chambers at 70 N. First Street, Campbell, California. Additional procedure will be detailed in the published meeting agenda; and any updated information will be posted to the City's website at www.campbellca.gov.



