NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council for the City of Campbell has set the hour of 7:30 p.m. or soon thereafter on **Tuesday, September 7, 2021**, at 70 N. First Street, Campbell, California, as the time and place for a for a Public Hearing to consider applications for Mills Act contracts for properties located at 73 S. 1st Street, 204 Alice Avenue, 51 Alice Avenue, and 81 Alice Avenue, commonly known as the Laura Campbell Swope House, the William & Dorothy (Mills) Harrison House, the Walter B. & Annie (Hall) Jones House, and the Doc and Cora Beal House, respectively. Staff is recommending that this project be deemed Categorical Exempt under CEQA.

While members of the public will not be able to attend the meeting of the Campbell City Council physically, the meeting will be live-streamed on YouTube at (<https://www.youtube.com/user/CityofCampbell>).

This public hearing will be conducted via telecommunication and is compliant with provisions of the Brown Act and Executive Order N-29-20 issued by the Governor.
