NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council for the City of Campbell has set the hour of 7:30 p.m. or soon thereafter on **Tuesday, February 1, 2022**, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 70 N. First Street, Campbell, California, as the time and place for a Public Hearing to consider an ordinance to extend Interim Ordinance No. 2277 that adopted urgency measures to implement Senate Bill No. 9 (SB-9), concerning two-unit developments and lot splits in single family residential zones; and adoption of new application fees for SB-9 applications to be included in the Schedule of Fees and Charges.

This public hearing will be conducted in person as well as telecommunication and is compliant with provisions of the Brown Act.

In the event the provisions of Assembly Bill 361 are adopted by the City Council before the date of this meeting so as to require virtual attendance by participants, additional procedures will be detailed on the published meeting agenda and any updated information will be posted to the City's website at www.campbellca.gov.

Please be advised that if you challenge the nature of the above in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the Public Hearing described in this Notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Clerk at, or prior to, the Public Hearing.
