NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Campbell has set the hour of 7:30 p.m., or shortly thereafter, on **Tuesday, April 19, 2022**, in the City Hall Council Chambers, at 70 N. First Street, Campbell, California, as the first meeting to hear public testimony and consider amending provisions of the Campbell Municipal Code to revise the business license tax rates by 2% as allowed by City of Campbell Ordinance 2132 and to account for inflation, effective in Fiscal Year 2023. Business activities and the corresponding tax amounts are listed in the published chart. The business license taxes are collected at time of business license application, and invoiced annually by the City upon renewal date. The total amount of business license tax to be collected by the City is estimated at \$700,000.

Subsequently, the City Council of the City of Campbell has set the hour of 7:30 p.m., or shortly thereafter, on **Tuesday, June 7, 2022**, in the City Hall Council Chambers, at 70 N. First Street, Campbell, California, as the time and place for a public hearing to consider adoption of the Ordinance amending provisions of the Campbell Municipal Code to officially revise the business license tax rates for Fiscal Year 2023.

Interested persons may appear and be heard at these hearings. Please be advised that if you challenge the nature of the above in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public meetings described in this Notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Clerk at, or prior to, the Public Hearing. This public hearing will be conducted in compliance with the Brown Act and held in person, however interested persons may attend electronically, to do so please register to attend at: <https://campbellca.gov/signup>. After registering, you will receive a confirmation email containing information about joining the meeting. The City Council meeting will be live-streamed on Channel 26, the City's website and on YouTube (<https://www.youtube.com/user/CityofCampbell>) for those who only wish to view the meeting.
