NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council for the City of Campbell has set the hour of 4:00 p.m. or soon thereafter on **Tuesday, April 18, 2023**, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 70 N. First Street, Campbell, California, as the time and place for a Public Hearing to Consider the Adoption of the 2040 General Plan (Envision Campbell), 2023-2031 Housing Element (Campbell's Plan for Housing), Recission of the South of Campbell Avenue Area Plan (SOCA), North of Campbell Avenue Plan (NOCA), Central Campbell Redevelopment Plan (CCRP), and Design Guidelines for Low-Medium Density Residential Projects, Reestablishment of Other Existing Area, Streetscape, and Neighborhood Plans, Establishment of a New Zoning Map, Amendments to Title 6 (Health and Sanitation), Title 7 (Animals), Title 20 (Subdivision and Land Development, and Title 21 (Zoning) of the Campbell Municipal Code, Adoption of Multi-Family Development and Design Standards and a Form-Based Zone Map, and Certification of a Final Programmatic Environmental Impact Report (EIR) with a Statement of Overriding Considerations in Accordance with CEQA. This public hearing will be conducted in person as well as telecommunication and is compliant with provisions of the Brown Act.

Please be advised that if you challenge the nature of the above in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the Public Hearing described in this Notice.
