**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City Council of the City of Campbell has set the hour of 7:30 p.m., or shortly thereafter, on **Tuesday, May 2, 2023** in the City Hall Council Chambers, at 70 N. First Street, Campbell, California, as the time and place for a Public Hearing to consider the requirements of Assembly Bill 481, review and renew Campbell Police Department Policy 709 - Military Equipment and review the AB 481 Military Equipment Annual Report 2022.

Interested persons may appear and be heard at this hearing. Please be advised that if you challenge the nature of the above in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the Public Hearing described in this Notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Clerk at, or prior to, the Public Hearing. This public hearing will be conducted in person as well as telecommunication and is compliant with provisions of the Brown Act. Interested persons may attend electronically, to do so please register to attend at: <https://campbellca.gov/signup>. After registering, you will receive a confirmation email containing information about joining the meeting. The City Council meeting will be live-streamed on Channel 26, the City's website and on YouTube (<https://www.youtube.com/user/CityofCampbell>) for those who only wish to view the meeting.
