NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Campbell has set the hour of 7:30 p.m., or shortly thereafter, on **Monday, January 22, 2024** in the City Hall Council Chambers, at 70 N. First Street, Campbell, California, as the time and place for a public hearing to Consider the Request of Salvatore Caruso to allow construction of a stacked two-level, 1,940 square-foot duplex on an existing residential property developed with a detached single-family home to remain, located at 105 Kennedy Avenue, including vacation and abandonment of an existing public sidewalk easement, and reconstruction of existing 6-foot fence. The Application under consideration is a Planned Development Permit submitted under an SB-330 pre-application filed in compliance with Government Code § 65941.1. File No.: PLN-2023-119.

Interested persons may appear and be heard at this hearing. Please be advised that if you challenge the nature of the above in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the Public Hearing described in this Notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Clerk at, or prior to, the Public Hearing. This public hearing will be conducted in person as well as telecommunication and is compliant with provisions of the Brown Act.
