



NOTICE OF INTENT

INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION CITY OF CAMPBELL, CALIFORNIA

Notice is hereby given of the intent of the City of Campbell to adopt a Negative Declaration for amendments to the Land Use and Circulation Element of the Campbell General Plan (Application #PLN2014-162).

The Initial Study and Negative Declaration evaluate the potential environmental impacts that might reasonably be anticipated resulting from the strategy and policy changes related to complying with the Complete Streets Act of 2008. The Complete Streets Act of 2008 requires cities to accommodate safe and convenient travel for all users including bicyclists, pedestrians, transit users and people of all ages and abilities in an effort to reduce automobile congestion and greenhouse gas emissions. The proposed amendment is not a comprehensive update of the Land Use and Circulation Element and does not propose density changes, motor vehicle traffic capacity changes or classification changes to the roadway system. The amendment is narrowly targeted to meeting the requirements of the Complete Streets Act and “leveling the playing field” for use of the roadway system by alternative means of transportation. It has been concluded that the project described above will not have a significant effect on the environment and a draft Negative Declaration has been prepared.

The public review period for the Negative Declaration begins on **June 18, 2013** and ends on **July 17, 2014**. Any comments must be submitted to the Public Works Department by 5:00 p.m. on July 17, 2014. Copies of the Initial Study and Negative Declaration are available for review from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Public Works Department, City Hall, 70 North First Street, Campbell, California.

The date for the required Planning Commission Public Hearing has been set for 7:30 p.m., or shortly thereafter, on July 22, 2014, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 70 North First Street, Campbell, California.

The date of the City Council Public Hearing has been tentatively set for 7:30 p.m., or shortly thereafter, on August 19, 2014, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 70 North First Street, Campbell, California.
