Project Title: 251 Llewellyn Avenue Residential Project

Project Location: 251 Llewellyn Avenue

Description of Project: The Project is a redevelopment of a 5.56-acre site currently developed with an institutional facility consisting of six structures operated by Pacific Clinics. The Project aims to demolish these structures and construct a medium-density residential community, including 18 single-family homes, 90 townhomes, and a recreational park, with a total site density of 19.4 units per acre. It will provide 260 parking spaces, including garage, guest, and motorcycle parking, accessed via Llewellyn and Latimer Avenues, and include typical landscaping, hardscape, and stormwater drainage improvements.

Basis of Determination: Sections 15183 and 15168 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), exempts from additional environmental review development projects that are consistent with the allowable density established by existing zoning, community plan or general plan policies for which an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was certified, except as might be necessary to examine whether there are project-specific significant effects which are peculiar to the project or its site.

Section 15183 further specifies that examination of environmental effects shall be limited to those effects that: (1) Are peculiar to the project or the parcel on which the project would be located, and were not analyzed as significant effects in the EIR on the zoning action, general plan, or community plan, with which the project is consistent, (2) Are potentially significant off-site impacts and cumulative impacts which were not discussed in the prior EIR prepared for the general plan,

result of substantial new information which was not known at the time the EIR was certified, are determined to have a more severe adverse impact than discussed in the prior EIR. Where an impact is not peculiar to the parcel or to the proposed project, has been addressed as a significant effect in the prior EIR, or can be substantially mitigated by the imposition of uniformly applied development policies or standards, then an additional EIR need not be prepared for that project solely on the basis of that impact.

As supported by substantial evidence in the administrative record, including technical studies that have been peer-reviewed by the City's environmental consultant, and as summarized in a Section 15183 Checklist, available for public review on the City's website and at the Campbell Community Development Department, the City has determined that the Project, inclusive of voluntary project commitments that are incorporated into the Project by reference, qualifies for an exemption from additional environmental review because it is consistent with the development density and use characteristics established by the Campbell 2040 General Plan, as analyzed by the Envision Campbell General Plan and Housing Element Update Final Program EIR (SCH # 2022030566), and all required findings can be affirmatively established .

On basis of the City's evaluation, in accordance with the requirements of Section 15183 of the CEQA Guidelines, the City of Campbell found:

1. The Project is consistent with the development density established by the 2040 Campbell General Plan for which a Final Program EIR was certified;
2. There are no project-specific effects which are peculiar to the Project or the Project Site, and which the Envision Campbell General Plan and Housing Element Update Final Program EIR failed to analyze as significant effects;
3. There are no potentially significant off-site and/or cumulative impacts which the Envision Campbell General Plan and Housing Element Update Final Program EIR failed to evaluate;
4. There is no substantial new information which results in more severe impacts than anticipated by the Envision Campbell General Plan and Housing Element Update Final Program EIR;
5. The Project will undertake feasible mitigation measures specified in the Envision Campbell General Plan and Housing Element Update Final Program EIR; and
6. There are no unusual circumstances that would prevent the project from qualifying as Exempt per Section 15300.2 of the CEQA Guidelines.

THEREFORE, the City of Campbell has deemed the Project categorically exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act. A record of the Project is available to the general public at the Community Development Department, City of Campbell, 70 N. First Street, Campbell, CA 95008.
