**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Campbell will hold a Public Hearing at its regularly scheduled meeting date and time of **Tuesday, October 6, 2015**, at 7:30 p.m., or shortly thereafter, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 70 North First Street, Campbell, California, to consider the application of Jeffery & Jessica Benesch for a Modification (PLN2015-204) to a previously-approved Planned Development Permit (PD89-24) to allow a 270 square foot second-story addition to an existing two-story residence on property located at **1424 Maysun Court** in a P-D (Planned Development) Zoning District. Staff is recommending that this project be deemed Categorical Exempt under CEQA.




