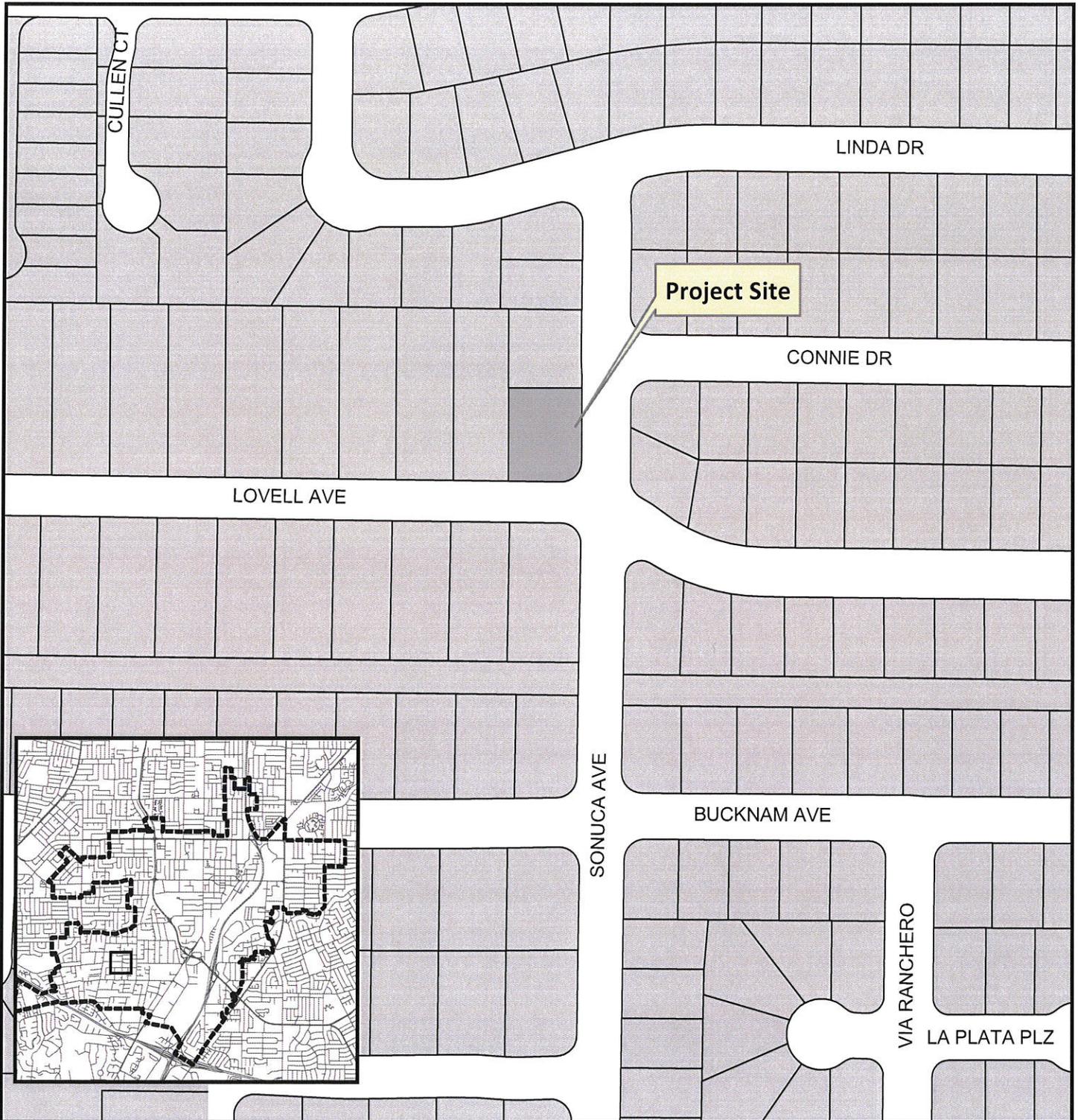

Project Location Map

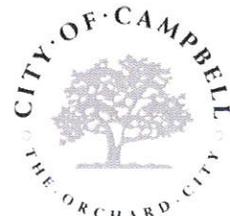
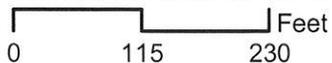
