### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council for the City of Campbell has set the hour of 7:30 p.m. or soon thereafter on **Tuesday October 4, 2016**, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 70 N. First Street, Campbell, California, as the time and place for a public hearing to receive citizen comments concerning the resolutions adopting housing mitigation fees for residential developments and commercial linkage fees for non-residential developments. The fees initiated or revised by this resolution are reasonably related to the need for affordable housing associated with development projects in the City of Campbell. A copy of the proposed fees and data regarding the need for affordable housing associated with development in the City of Campbell, including the cost of affordable housing and funds available to provide affordable housing, is available for review at the office of Community Development Department, Campbell, California. The adoption of the resolutions is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act because the resolutions create a governmental funding mechanism which does not involve any commitment to a specific project that may result in a potentially significant effect on the environment. (CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(4).)

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that if you challenge the adoption of these resolutions in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at public hearings before the City of Campbell or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Campbell at, or prior to, the public hearing.

Interested persons may appear and be heard at said hearing. In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, listening devices are available for all meetings held in the Council Chambers.
