NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Historic Preservation Board of the City of Campbell has set the time of 4:00 p.m., or shortly thereafter, on Wednesday, **October 26, 2016**, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 70 North First Street, Campbell, California, for a Public Hearing to consider the application of Robert Nicoletti for a Mills Act Historic Property Contract for consideration under the Mills Act Tax Incentive Program on property located at **226 Alice Avenue** within the Alice Avenue Historic District. The property has a zoning designation of R-1-6H (Single-Family Residential/Historic Overlay). Designation of the property as a Mills Act property would be Categorically Exempt under Section 15331, Class 31 of the California Environment Quality Act (CEQA), pertaining to projects involving the maintenance, rehabilitation, restoration, preservation, or reconstruction of historical resources.

Interested persons may appear and be heard at said hearing. In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, listening devices are available for all meetings held in the Council Chambers. Project Location Map


