





Tree Removal Permit




Basis of Decision: Based upon a review of the application materials and an inspection of the property, the Community Development Director has approved removal of one oak tree located in the backyard, finding that due to its proximity to overhead utility lines where interference cannot be controlled or remedied through reasonable modification/relocation of the utilities or reasonable modification of the tree's branch structure (satisfying Finding No. 2 – Utility Interference). Removal of the tree is subject to the replanting requirement of the Campbell Municipal Code.

Appeal Process: Decisions by the Community Development Director are final in 10 calendar days following the date of approval, unless an appeal is received in writing at the City of Campbell Community Development Department, 70 N. First Street, Campbell, prior to the end of the appeal period (**October 31, 2016**). A written appeal must be accompanied by the required \$200 appeal filing fee.

A copy of the Tree Removal Permit application, and all associated documents, are available for review from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Community Development Department, City Hall, 70 North First Street, Campbell, California. Project Location Map


