NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Historic Preservation Board

Notice is hereby given that the Historic Preservation Board of the City of Campbell has set the time of 5:00 p.m., or shortly thereafter, on Wednesday, **October 25, 2017**, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 70 North First Street, Campbell, California, for a Public Hearing to consider the Conditional Use Permit application (PLN2017-164) to allow construction of an addition to, and remodel of, a home on property located at **20 Alice Avenue** in the R-1-6 (Single Family Residential) Zoning District and the Alice Avenue Historic District. Staff is recommending that the project be exempt from CEQA because the project will follow the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties and therefore would not cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of the historical resource.

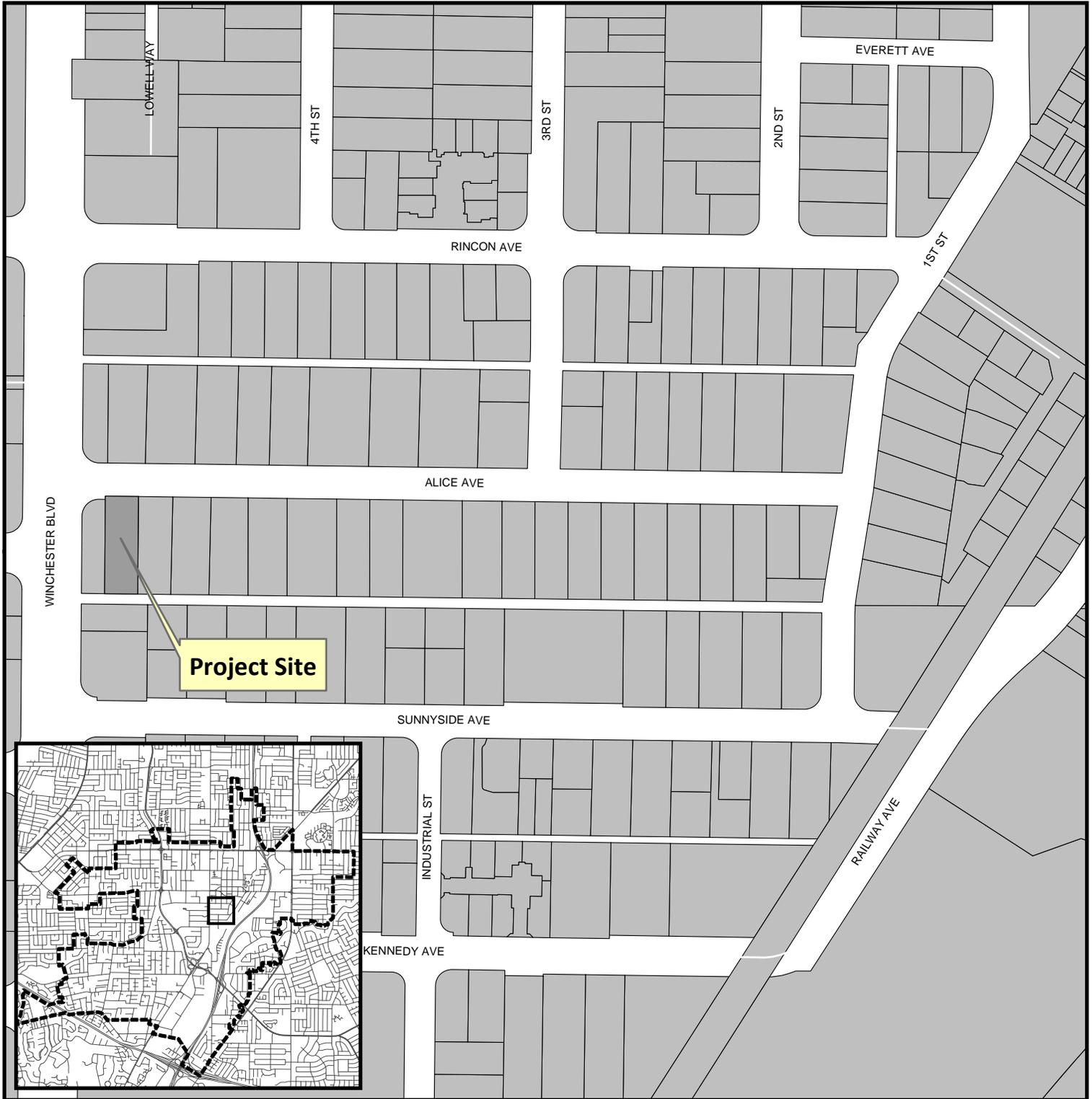
