NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Campbell has set the time of 7:30 p.m., or shortly thereafter, on Tuesday, **February 5, 2013**, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 70 North First Street, Campbell, California, as the time and place for a Public Hearing to consider the City Initiated application for the designation of up to 15 properties as Historic Resource Inventory Properties (PLN2012-236). The following properties are under consideration as Historic Resources: **422-428 E. Campbell Avenue, 866 E. Campbell Avenue, 167 Harrison Avenue, 1075 W. Latimer Avenue, 96 E. Rincon Avenue, 118 E. Rincon Avenue, 166 E. Rincon Avenue, 176 E. Rincon Avenue, 186 E. Rincon Avenue, 74 N. Second Street, 119 S. Second Street, 222 N. Third Street, 61 S. Fourth Street, 68 S. Fourth Street (aka 70 S. Fourth Street) and 96 S. Fourth Street.** Staff is recommending that this project be deemed Categorical Exempt under CEQA.

Interested persons may appear and be heard at this hearing. Please be advised that if you challenge the nature of the above project in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the Public Hearing described in this Notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Campbell Planning Commission at, or prior to, the Public Hearing.
