NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Campbell will hold a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, February 1, 2022, at 7:45 p.m.**, at 70 North First Street, Campbell, California. This will be the third in a series of four public hearings to obtain public input on the future of redrawing the City Council Election district boundaries. The community's input is extremely important to this process.

This public hearing will be conducted in compliance with the Brown Act and held in person, however interested persons may attend electronically, to do so please register to attend at: <https://campbelca.gov/signup>. After registering, you will receive a confirmation email containing information about joining the meeting.

The City Council meeting will be live-streamed on Channel 26, the City's website and on YouTube (<https://www.youtube.com/user/CityofCampbell>) for those who only wish to view the meeting.

In the event the provisions of Assembly Bill 361 are adopted by the City Council before the date of this meeting so as to require virtual attendance by participants, additional procedures will be detailed on the published meeting agenda; and any updated information will be posted to the City's website at www.campbelca.gov.

In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, the City of Campbell will generally, upon request, provide appropriate aids and services leading to effective communication for qualified persons with disabilities so they can participate equally in the public hearings, including qualified sign language interpreters, assistive listening devices, and other ways of making information and communications accessible to people who have speech, hearing, or vision impairments.
