Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Campbell has set the time of 7:30 p.m., or shortly thereafter, on Tuesday, **January 3, 2012**, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 70 North First Street, Campbell, California, for a Public Hearing to consider the Appeal of Sunny Tam, AIA and Melodann, Inc. of the Planning Commission decision denying a Conditional Use Permit (PLN2011-111) to allow the establishment of a combined restaurant/nightclub (Dasha) with general alcohol sales, live entertainment, and late night activity on property located at 400 E. Campbell Avenue (Gaslighter Theatre) in the C-3 (Central Business District) Zoning District. Staff is recommending that this project be deemed Statutorily Exempt under CEQA.

Interested persons may appear and be heard at this hearing. Please be advised that if you challenge the nature of the above project in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the Public Hearing described in this Notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Campbell Planning Commission at, or prior to, the Public Hearing. 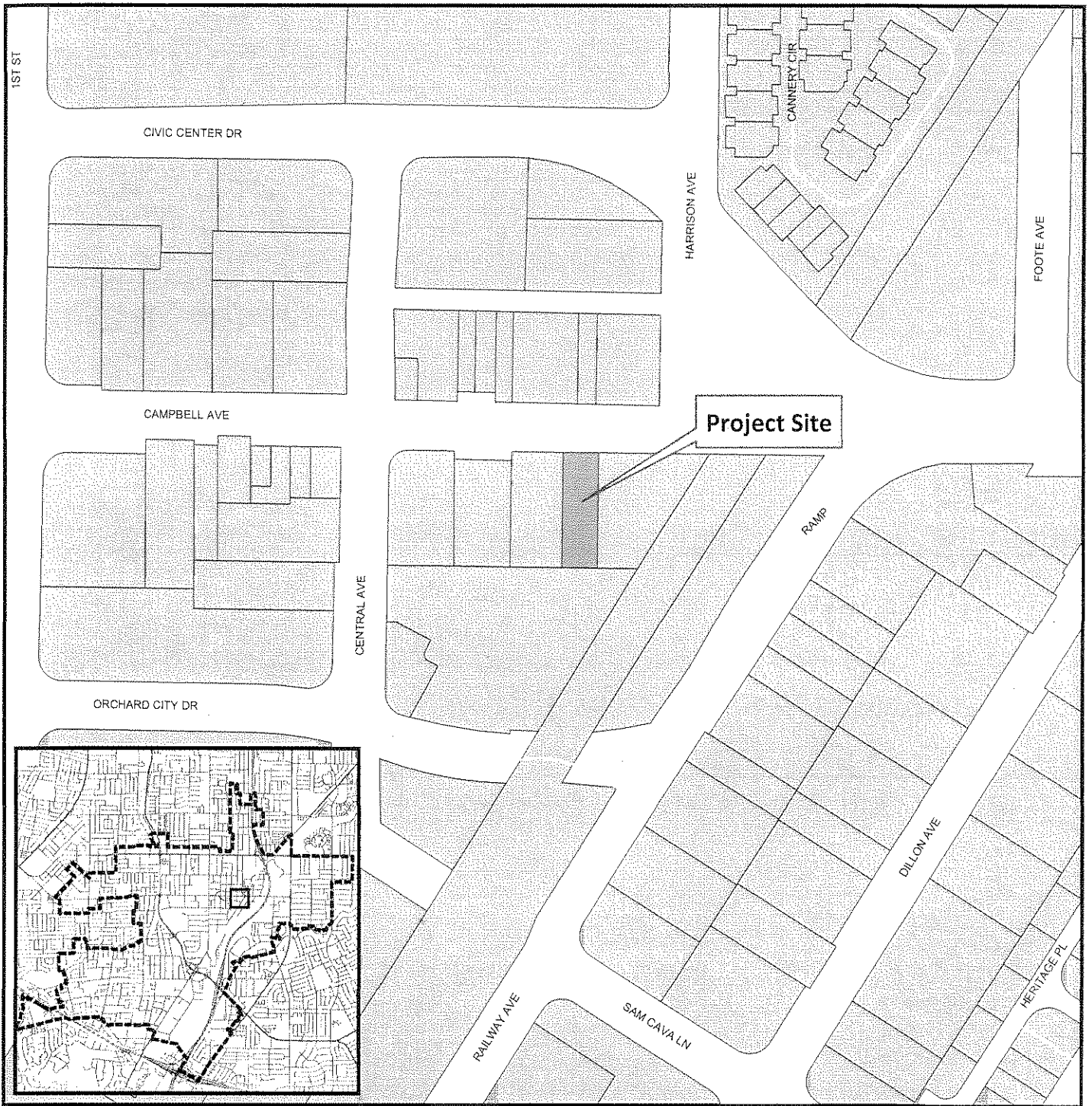

Project Location Map

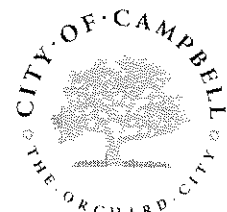
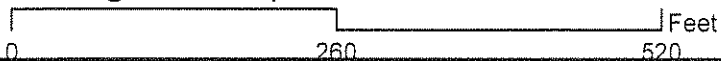
