Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Campbell has set the time of 7:30 p.m., or shortly thereafter, on Tuesday, **February 7, 2012**, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 70 North First Street, Campbell, California, as the time and place for a Public Hearing to consider an Appeal of Lisa Kusaba, on behalf of several residents, of the Planning Commission decision approving the application of Scott McCurry, on behalf of Campbell Christian School, for a Conditional Use Permit with Site and Architectural Review (PLN2011-202) and a Parking Modification Permit (PLN2011-222) to construct a new 26,394 square foot, two-story classroom and gymnasium building within an existing private school campus on property located at 1075 W. Campbell Avenue. Staff is recommending this project be deemed Categorical Exempt under CEQA.

Interested persons may appear and be heard at this hearing. Please be advised that if you challenge the nature of the above project in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the Public Hearing described in this Notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Clerk at, or prior to the Public Hearing. 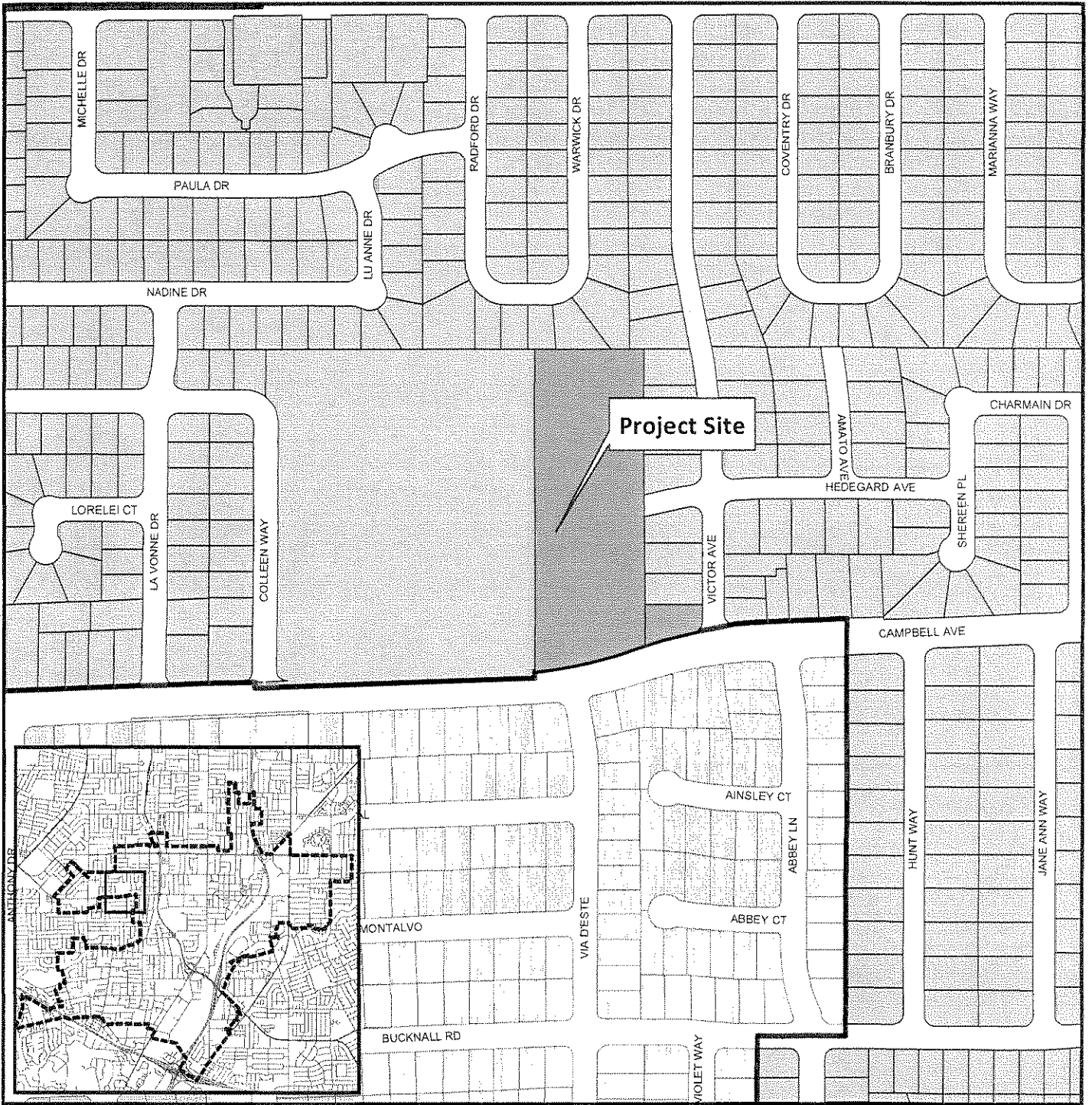

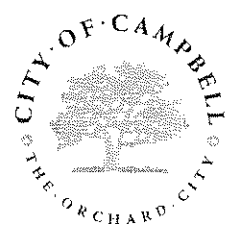
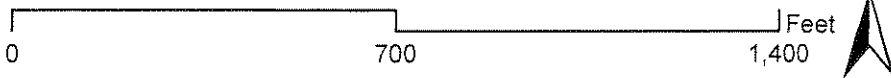
