NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Campbell has set the hour of 7:30 p.m., or shortly thereafter, on **Tuesday, April 21, 2015**, in the City Hall Council Chamber, 70 N. First Street, Campbell, California, as the time and place for a Public Hearing to consider an Appeal of the Planning Commission decision denying the Appeal of Ryan Gleason, on behalf of Goodwill of Silicon Valley, requesting the elimination of one imposed Condition of Approval 4-b of the Administrative Planned Development Permit (PLN2013-229) as it pertains to the placement of a Goodwill donation and recycling collection facility on property located at **2341 S. Winchester Boulevard**. Staff is recommending that this project be deemed Categorical Exempt under CEQA.

Interested persons may appear and be heard at this hearing. Please be advised that if you challenge the nature of any of the above project in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the Public Hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Clerk at or prior to the hearing. 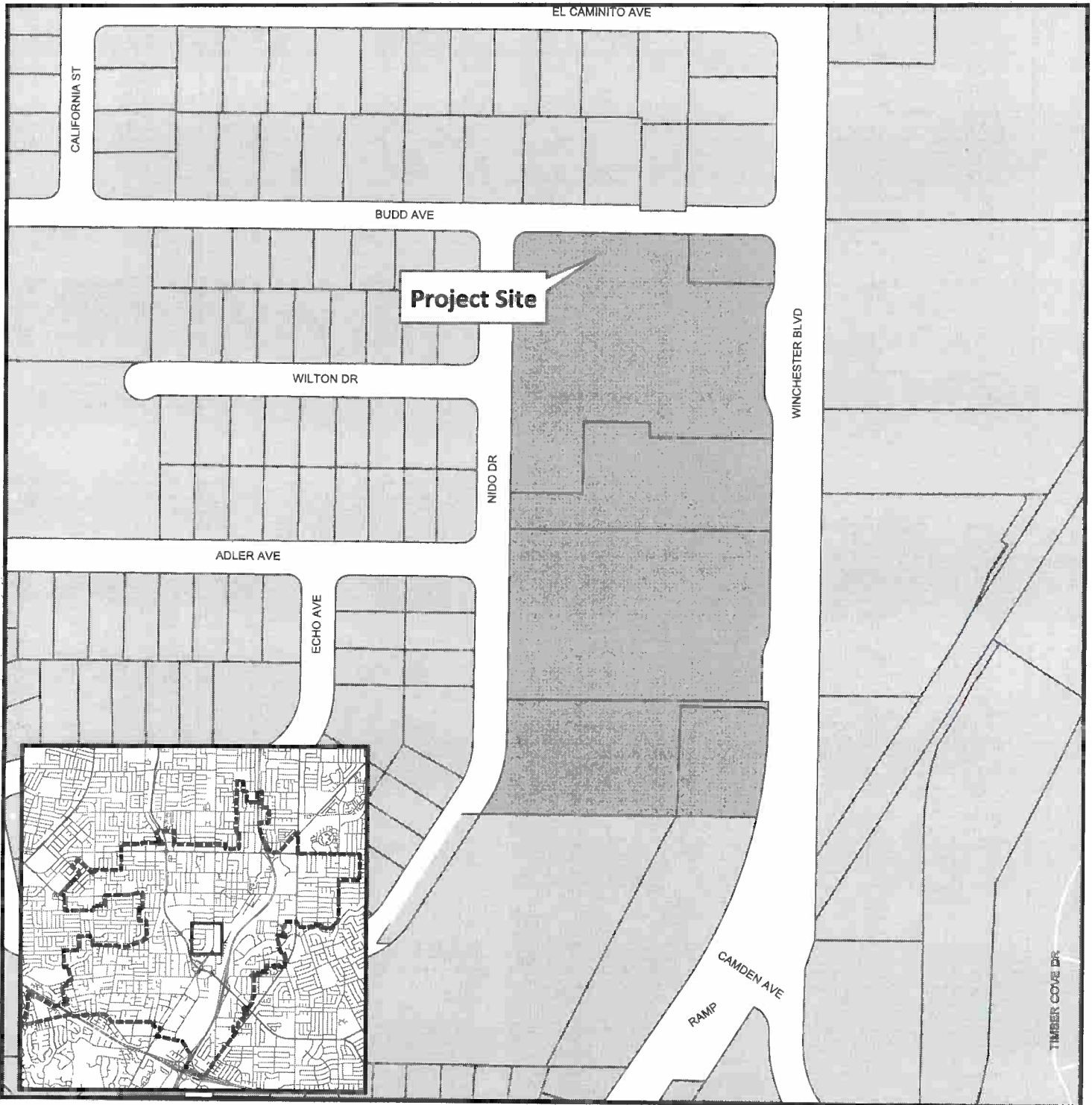

Project Location Map

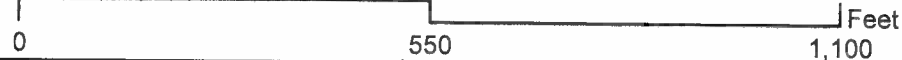
