## Information for Campbell Voters:

Measure O was placed on the ballot by the City of Campbell to fund a police emergency operations center that is fully operational during a disaster and an energy-efficient library in seismically safe and accessible facilities that meet current safety codes. Measure O would authorize up to \$50 million in general obligation bonds, with projected levies of \$0.019 per \$100 (\$19 per \$100,000) of assessed value, generating roughly \$3 million annually to repay bonds, establish a citizens' oversight committee and require mandatory annual financial audits.



## Learn More About Measure O: Campbell Police and Library Facilities Bond Measure

The Campbell City Council placed Measure O on the November 6, 2018 ballot to provide funding to make our library and police facilities safe and accessible. If approved by voters, the measure would provide funding for:



### Police Facility Improvements

- New police and 9-1-1 emergency response facilities that would remain fully operational during a disaster, be seismically safe, and provide infrastructure that will allow the police to better utilize up-to-date crime-fighting technology



### Library Improvement

- Provide a safe, energy-efficient library that meets current safety codes for earthquakes and fires, with space for senior reading, after-school homework programs, children's story times, community events and public computers, ensuring accessibility for seniors and residents with disabilities




## Understanding the Need

Most of the Campbell Police Department is currently working in a portable building that has not kept up with modern needs, such as sufficient evidence processing, interview rooms, holding cells and operational briefing areas, and does not meet current earthquake safety standards for essential facilities. Campbell's library experiences building system failures to the elevator, heating and air conditioning, plumbing and electrical, and lacks flexible space. Neither the police's portable unit nor library facilities meet current State-mandated accessibility standards. If approved by voters, Measure O would provide funding to address these issues.

## Fiscal Accountability

Measure O will establish a citizens' oversight committee and require annual financial audits. If approved by the voters, all of the funds would be spent on local facilities.
