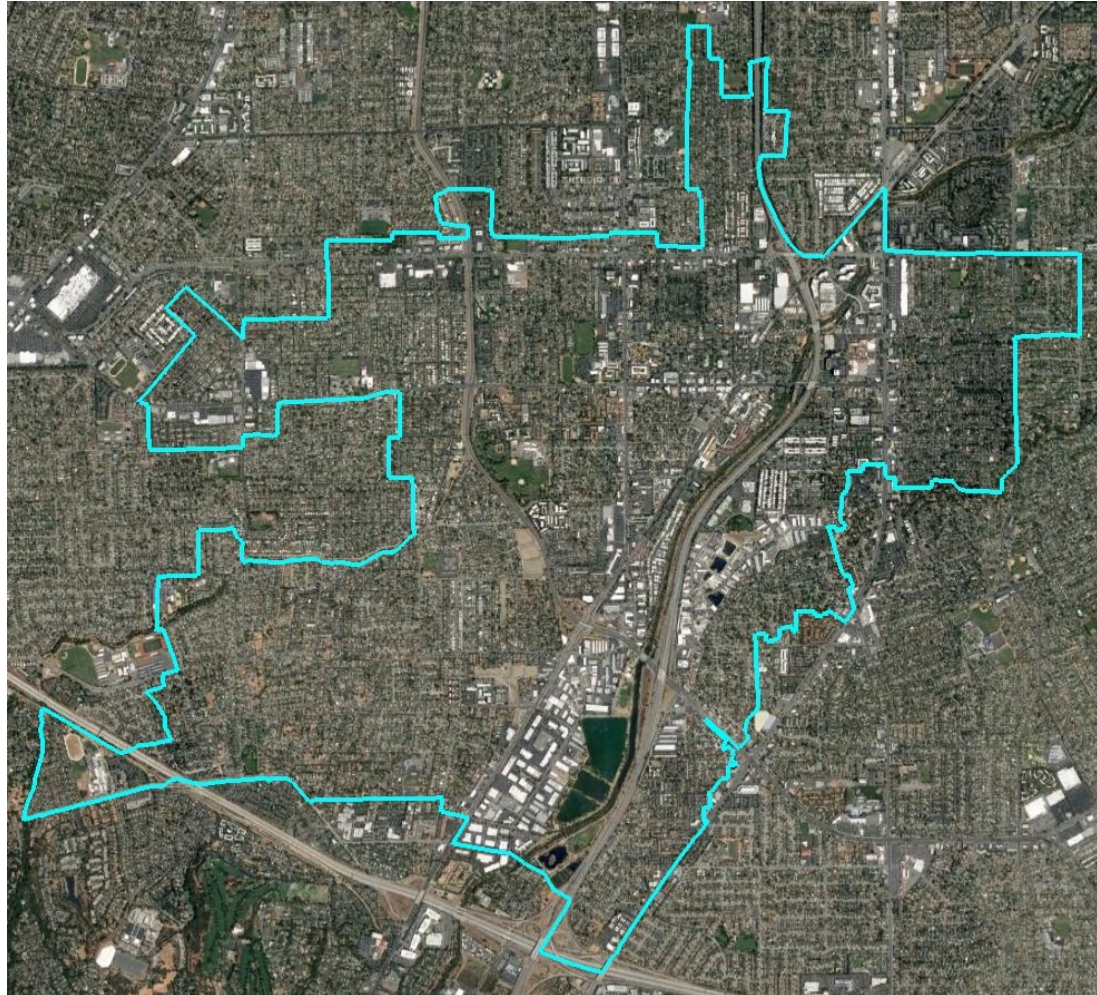

Districting Process

2

Step	Description
Two Initial Hearings March 19 & April 2	Held prior to release of draft maps. Education and to solicit input on the communities in the District. Submit draft maps by May 14
Release draft maps	Maps must be posted at least 7 days prior to 3 rd hearing.
Two hearings on draft maps June 4 & 18	Two meetings to discuss and revise the draft maps and to discuss the election sequence.
Introduce Ordinance and Final Adoption July 2	Final map must be posted at least 7 days prior to adoption.
November 2020	First by-district election held in two districts.
2021	Trustee areas revised to reflect 2020 Census data.
November 2022	First by-district election held in remaining districts.

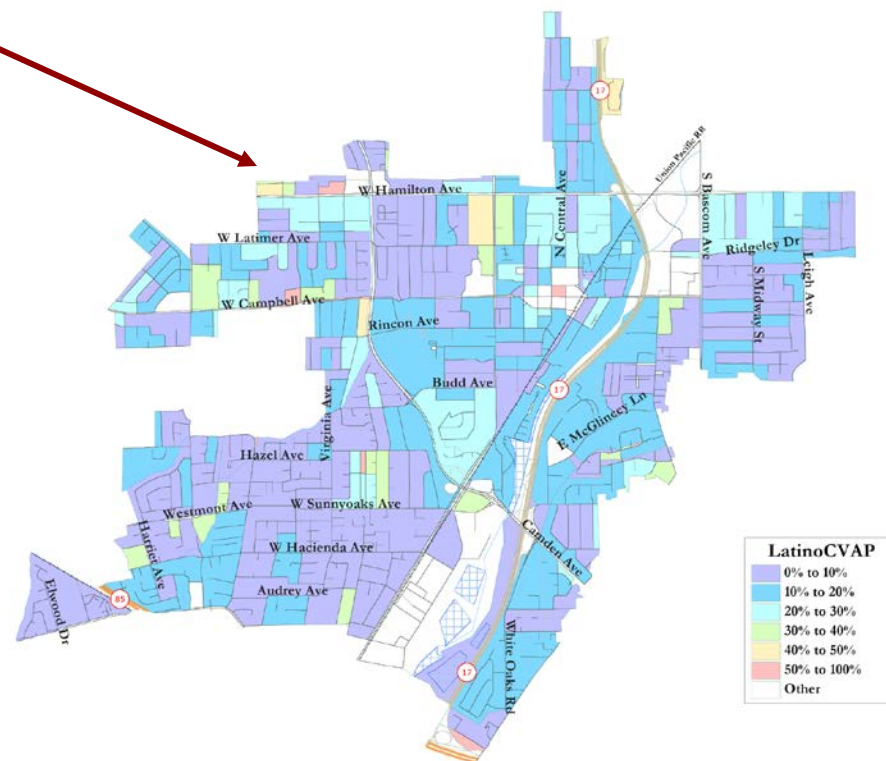
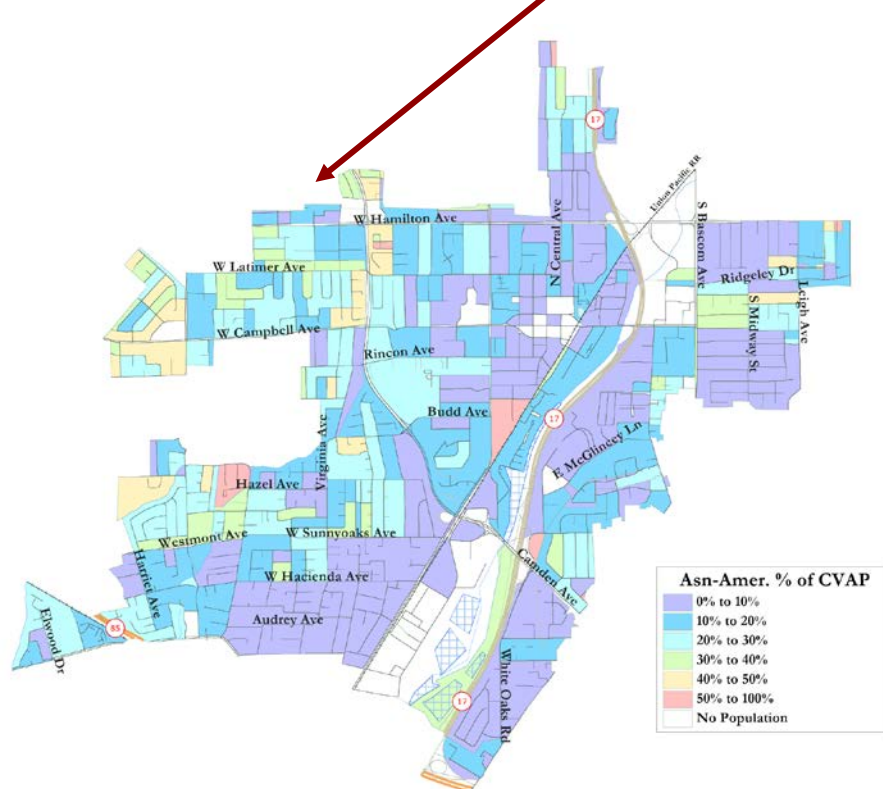

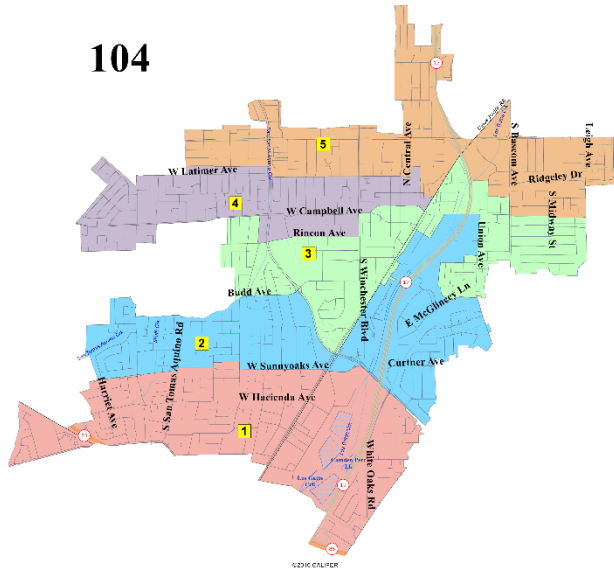
Asian-American and Latino eligible voters are more concentrated in the northwest part of the city.



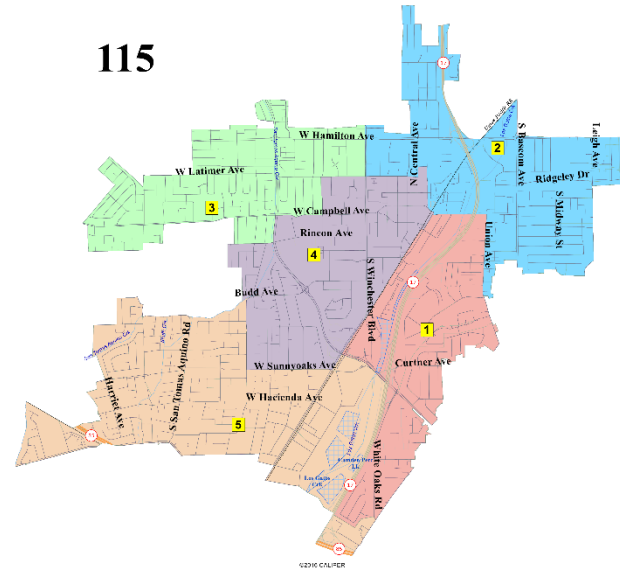
