ADVANCE NOTIFICATION FOR UPCOMING STREET IMPROVEMENTS AND STREET RESURFACING PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Annual Street Maintenance Project 21-BB: Collector & Residential Street Resurfacing Program

WHO: O'Grady Paving of Mountain View, California

WHAT / WHY: O'Grady Paving was hired by the City of Campbell to construct the Annual Street Maintenance Project 21-BB: Collector & Residential Street Resurfacing Program. The project will resurface various street sections within the City of Campbell. Street resurfacing (via slurry seal, rubber cape seal or hot mix asphalt concrete (HMAC) overlay) are all economical and efficient ways that extend the service life of City's streets to levels of service expected by the residents of Campbell.

WHERE: See Location Map on the backside of this notice for affected streets, their limits and treatment type.

WHEN: Work on this project will start in June 2021 and will be substantially completed by October 2021. In general, working hours are from 8AM to 5PM, Monday through Friday.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Typical construction noise and minor traffic delays are to be expected during construction hours.
- On street parking will be restricted at times. On-street parking restrictions will be posted 72-hours prior to work commencing. Please note that the posted parking restrictions will be strictly enforced. Any vehicles parked within the construction zone will be towed away by the Campbell Police Department at the owner's expense.
- Properties directly affected by any construction work will be re-notified 72-hours prior to work commencing.
- In general, work will be completed in the following order:
 1. Concrete improvements (ie. accessibility ramps; traffic spot islands; minor curb & gutter, sidewalk & driveway repair)
 2. Isolated pavement failure area repair (ie. digout operation)
 3. Weed abatement and crack sealing
 4. Trimming of street trees that could potentially impede the progress of the street resurfacing work.
 5. Wedge grinding along the lip of gutter for streets slated to receive a hot mix asphalt concrete (HMAC) overlay treatment
 6. Pavement striping, markings and marker removal
 7. Rubber chip seal application
 8. HMAC Overlay
 9. Slurry seal application
 10. Striping replacement
 11. Utility adjustments

EFFECT ON OTHER SERVICES (IE. GARBAGE, MAIL, AND BUS):

You should not expect any change in scheduled dates for delivery or pick-up services (i.e. mail and/or garbage & recycling collection). Bus service where applicable will remain operational.

ADVISORIES:

- **WATCH FOR SIGNS & WORKERS** – For your safety and for the safety of the construction workers, please obey all posted traffic control signs and instructions from construction workers.
- **PLAN AHEAD** – You will be reminded at various stages throughout the construction of this project where and when work will be occurring. For updates, visit the City's Project webpage at <https://www.ci.campbell.ca.us/1136/Annual-Street-Maintenance-Project-2021>.
- **BE PATIENT** – Noise, debris, and delays on this type of construction project is unavoidable. Please understand that the crews will be working diligently to minimize the construction impact to your daily lives.
