

IMPORTANT 72-HOUR NOTICE FOR

SAMI / RUBBER CHIP SEAL & STREET PAVING OPERATIONS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

**Annual Street Maintenance Project 21-BB:
Collector & Residential Street Resurfacing Program**

WHO: O'Grady Paving Inc., (under contract with the City of Campbell)

WHAT: Your street is scheduled for a resurfacing. The nature of your street resurfacing is a three-step process.
Step 1: It will be necessary to grind a "key" or "conform" in the pavement along the gutter line and at intersecting side streets.
Step 2: A stress absorbing membrane interlayer (SAMI) otherwise known as a rubber chip seal will be applied to the surface of the roadway. This is done to prevent water from penetrating through the cracks in the roadway section.
Step 3: A 2-inch thick hot mix asphalt concrete overlay will be installed as the final wearing course.

WHERE: Work will occur on:

1. Browning Way from White Oaks Road to Holmes Avenue.
2. Louise Court from Hazelwood Avenue to the End.

WHEN: **Step 1: Pavement Grinding Operation** – Work will occur on Friday, July 30, 2021.
Step 2: SAMI / Rubber Chip Seal Application – Work will occur on Monday, August 2, 2021
Step 3: Street Paving Operation – Work will occur on Tuesday, August 10, 2021.
Working hours will be 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Typical construction noise, dust, and odors.
- Uneven driving surfaces.
- Potential traffic/driveway delays and lane closures.
- Posted traffic control signs. For your safety and for the safety of the workers in the field, please obey all posted traffic control signs and construction workers.
- On street parking will be restricted during this construction operation. Posted restrictions will be enforced. Any vehicles parked within the construction zone will be towed away by the Campbell Police Department at the owner's expense.

ADVISORIES:

- Do put your garbage out on garbage day. O'Grady Paving has made arrangements with West Valley Collection and Recycling to do early morning pick-ups.
- Do not wash your cars or water your lawns the day before, the day work is scheduled, and the day after.
- Do not drive, walk, bike, play, skate, or allow pets on the newly sealed street until it has had time to cure.
- Do not perform any $\frac{3}{4}$ - turns or make any sudden/hard stops with your vehicle for several days after the application of the material.
- Do drive slowly on the newly resurfaced street for several days.
