Once your application is reviewed by staff and deemed complete and approved, you will be formally notified. The actual amount of the grant depends on the number of applications approved. The property and business owner will need to sign an agreement with the City that delineates terms and conditions of the grant. State law AB 562 requires a public hearing, identification of economic benefits (jobs and tax revenue projections expected from the public assistance) and posting of names of grant recipients and grant amounts on the City's website.
