

PICNIC RULES & REGULATIONS

**TAKE YOUR RESERVATION PERMIT WITH YOU TO THE PARK. IF YOU HAVE ANY ISSUES,
PLEASE CONTACT THE CAMPBELL POLICE DEPARTMENT AT (408) 866-2101.
ALL PARKING REGULATIONS ARE STRICTLY ENFORCED**

- 1. BEER AND WINE MAY BE CONSUMED ONLY WITH AN APPROVED PICNIC RESERVATION PERMIT AND ONLY IN A RESERVED PICNIC AREA (CMC 13.04.160). NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY BE CONSUMED IN ANY OTHER AREAS. NO OTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED ON THE PREMISES. SELLING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IS PROHIBITED.**
- 2. SMALL INFLATABLES/BOUNCE-ABOUTS (JUMP HOUSES) ARE ONLY ALLOWED WITH AN APPROVED PICNIC RESERVATION PERMIT IN SITES #1-4.** Bounce-Abouts may only be provided by companies that have a current Certificate of Liability Insurance and Business License on file with the City of Campbell. A list of such companies is available on the City's website www.campbellca.gov/picnics. Inflatables may not exceed 20x20 in size.
3. Cancellations and requests for date/location change of picnic reservations must be made in writing and received by the Recreation & Community Services Department at least 15 days in advance of the use date. The \$25 processing fee is non-refundable and will be deducted from all refunds for cancellations. Date or locations changes can be made with no fee, but no refund will be provided if you wish to cancel after a date change has been made.
4. If it rains on your scheduled use date, you must call (408) 866-2104 the next business day to inquire about a full refund or re-scheduling your use to another available date. (Please allow 2-3 weeks for refunds.)
5. The City of Campbell programs and activities have priority over all other uses.
6. A one (1) day priority period is given to Campbell Residents for picnic reservations. Verification will be required before reservation is made. Reservations for park facilities may be made no more than 180 days for Campbell Residents (179 days for non-residents of Campbell) and no less than 2 calendar days prior to the desired date of use. Reservations may be made online 24 hours a day or over the phone 408-866-2104 Monday-Friday 8am-5pm
7. Athletic uses must be restricted to designated field area. Volleyball/Badminton must be set-up away from walking paths and picnic area.
8. Individual minors or groups of minors must be properly supervised by adults when using park facilities.
9. Each group using park facilities is responsible for the condition in which you leave the facilities & equipment. Users must deposit litter and debris in receptacles provided and all decorations must be removed. (All decorations must be flame retardant.) **NO DUNK BOOTHS OR OTHER EQUIPMENT. NO AMPLIFIED MUSIC. NO ADDITIONAL TABLES OR CHAIRS. ONLY ONE (1) 10X10 POP-UP TENT IS ALLOWED. NO MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE PARK (ON PATHWAYS OR ON GROUNDS).** All vehicles must be parked in designated parking stalls only. Vehicles observed in the park will be cited by the Campbell Police Department.
10. The City of Campbell is not responsible for accidents, injuries or loss of or damage to individual property.
11. No person shall enter or remain in any City or County Park one-half hour after sunset until sunrise the following day, unless for a special event sanctioned by the City and approved by the Recreation & Community Services Director.
12. Dogs on leash are permitted at all City parks, except in Children's Play Areas, during Athletic Games/Practices or during Special Events.
13. The misuse of a public park facility or the failure to conform to established policies, procedures, rules and regulations is sufficient reason for denying future applications.
