- The City works closely with the West Valley Clean Water Authority and the Santa Clara Urban Runoff Pollution Prevention Program to consistently minimize pollution entering our storm drains, creeks, and other water bodies. www.cleancreeks.org
- The City is a member of the West Valley Solid Waste Management Authority, overseeing contracts for waste hauling and processing to ensure proper disposal of solid waste and diversion of recycling and organics from landfills. Together, they offer resources for the disposal, recycling, or repurposing of items like hazardous waste, bulk items, and used cooking oil. www.WestValleyRecycles.com
- The City of Campbell partners with San Jose Water Company and Valley Water to enforce water conservation regulations.

Water Conservation:

- Residents and businesses can access resources like low-flow shower heads, aerators, lawn replacement, and Home Water Use Reports to monitor and control water consumption.
- Valley Water rebates to transform lawns into beautiful water-wise landscape. Up to \$3000 is available per residence and up to \$100,000 per commercial and multi-family sites. www.valleywater.org
