



2-Week Advance Notification for UPCOMING ENHANCEMENTS Please Read Carefully

Campbell PDA Enhancements on Civic Center Drive at 2nd and 3rd Streets

WHO: Guerra Construction Group of Santa Clara, California

WHAT/WHY: Guerra Construction Group was hired by the City of Campbell to construct the Campbell PDA Enhancements project. This project will be focusing on enhancements on Civic Center Drive at 2nd and 3rd Streets.

WHERE: This project will be focusing on enhancements on Civic Center Drive at 2nd and 3rd Streets.

WHEN: Work on this project will start in March 24, 2025 and will be substantially completed by August 2025. In general, working hours are from 8am – 5pm, Monday through Friday.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Typical construction noise and minor traffic delays are to be expected during construction hours.
- On street parking will be restricted at times. On-street parking restrictions will be posted 72 hours prior to work commencing. Please note that the posted parking restrictions will be strictly enforced. Any vehicles parked within the construction zone will be towed away by the Campbell Police Department at the owner's expense.
- Properties directly affected by any construction work will be re-notified 72 hours prior to work commencing.
- In general, work will be completed in the following order:
 - o Concrete improvements (ie. accessibility ramp installation; minor curb & gutter, sidewalk repair).
 - o Trimming of street trees could potentially impede the progress of the paving and street sealing work.
 - o Wedge grinding along the lip of gutter for streets slated to receive a hot mix asphalt concrete (HMAC) overlay treatment
 - o Rubber chip seal application
 - o Approximately one week after the rubber chip, the slurry seal application on streets scheduled to receive the rubber cape seal treatment or slurry seal treatment.
 - o Striping adjustments
 - o Installation of bulb outs, ADA-compliant accessibility curb ramps, spot islands, signing and striping, bio-retention basin, storm inlets, and relocation of rapid flashing beacon system and streetlight.

EFFECT ON OTHER SERVICES (IE. GARBAGE, MAIL, AND BUS):

You should not expect any change in scheduled dates for delivery or pick-up services (i.e. mail and/or garbage & recycling collection). Bus service where applicable will remain operational.

ADVISORIES:

- **WATCH FOR SIGNS & WORKERS** – For your safety and for the safety of the construction workers, please obey all posted traffic control signs and instructions from construction workers.
- **PLAN AHEAD** – You will be reminded at various stages throughout the construction of the project where and when work will be occurring. For updates, visit the City's Project webpage at: <https://www.campbellca.gov/1485/Campbell-Priority-Development-Area-PDA-P>.
- **BE PATIENT** – Noise, debris, and delays on this type of construction project is unavoidable. Please understand that the crew will be working diligently to minimize the construction impact to your daily lives.
