

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- Typical construction noise
- Minor traffic delays
- Construction dust and debris
- Posted traffic control signs
- On-street parking restrictions
- No change in garbage or mail service
- 72-hour advance notification for construction work happening in front of your property.

ADVISORIES:

- **WATCH FOR SIGNS & WORKERS** – For your safety and for the safety of the construction workers, please obey all posted traffic control signs and instructions/directions from construction workers in the field.
- **PLAN AHEAD** – You will be reminded at various stages throughout the construction of any project where and when work will be occurring. - **PARK ELSEWHERE** – Posted parking restrictions will be strictly enforced. Any vehicles parked within the construction zone will be towed away by the Campbell Police Department at the owner's expense.
- **BE PATIENT** – Disturbance, dust, debris, and delays on a construction project are unavoidable. Understand that the construction crews work diligently to minimize the construction impact to your daily lives.
