## CIVIC IMPROVEMENT COMMISSION ANNOUNCES 2017 STUDENT POSTER CONTEST WINNERS

*Rolling Hills Middle School 5<sup>th</sup> grader wins mountain bike for best poster*

Campbell, CA – At the City of Campbell’s Civic Improvement Commission (CIC) meeting on May 25, the commission announced the winners of the City’s annual Student Poster Contest.

The contest was open to all 5<sup>th</sup> grade students residing, or attending a public or private school, in Campbell. This year’s poster theme was “What I Love About Campbell” with students invited to creatively express their favorite places, attractions or activities in the Orchard City. Forty-five entries were received from four local elementary schools (ie, Forest Hill School, Rolling Hills Middle School, San Jose Christian and St. Lucy’s School), and were judged based in part on adherence to the contest’s theme, along with creativity, neatness, legibility, spelling and grammar.

The grand prize, a brand new mountain bike donated by Wheel Away Cycle Center of Campbell, was awarded to Tauren Mitchell. Tauren is a 5<sup>th</sup> grade student in Ms. Blesilda Ilano-Tenorio’s class at Rolling Hills Middle School in Campbell. The top ten awardees were recognized and presented prizes and certificates at the CIC special meeting. The full list of winners is shown at the end of this press release.
