

MODEL ROCKET USE GUIDELINES

Campbell Municipal Code Chapter 13.04.060
Park Use Regulations

1. Model Rocket launches in Campbell are restricted to specific areas of John D. Morgan Park and the Campbell Community Center.
2. Permits will be issued to Campbell residents only. **(Permit holder must be 18 years of age or older)**
3. Permits are required by the Santa Clara County Fire Department and the City of Campbell Recreation and Community Services Department.
4. Launch permits are subject to the following minimum requirements:
 - Limited to A & B sized rocket engines
 - Launch site and conditions must adhere to the National Fire Protection Association Standard #1122 "Code for Model Rocketry."
 - Permit holder must provide a 2A 10BC rated fire extinguisher for launch site.
5. Facility use permits are required by the City of Campbell Recreation and Community Services Department will be granted, at no charge, in adherence with the following conditions:
 - Permits shall be issued for times that are not in conflict with pre-scheduled organized activities.
 - Permits shall be issued for a specific date and time. A separate permit will be required for each launch date.
 - Facility use permits shall be issued only to those holding a Launch Permit issued from the Santa Clara County Fire Department.
6. All guidelines and permits stated above are to be agreed upon and signed by the applicant.
7. Applicants must sign a hold harmless agreement releasing the City from liability resulting from rocket launches.
8. Violators will be subject to **Penalties set forth in 13.04.170 of the Campbell Municipal Code.**

Launch Permits may be obtained at the Santa Clara County Fire Department (SCCFD) administrative offices located at 14700 Winchester Blvd. For information on Launch Permits call SCCFD at (408) 378-4010.
